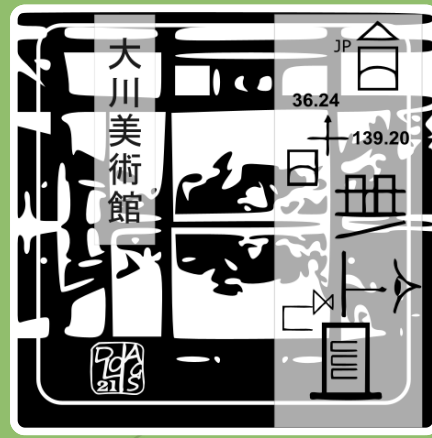




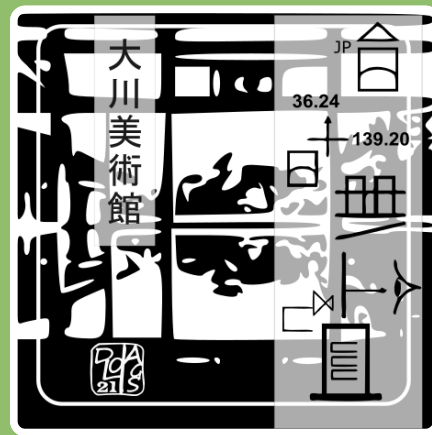

Ōkawa Museum of Art
